What is it?

Ready, Set, Launch is an RWC training developed in partnership with Community Sponsorship Hub (CSH) to support development and management of co-sponsorship programs. It is designed for employees responsible for designing and/or implementing a community sponsorship program at a national or local refugee resettlement agency.

What does it cover?

The training guides affiliate staff through key program design and management topics including:

- Effectively communicating what refugee resettlement is to prospective sponsors.
- Understanding sponsorship and various forms of community sponsorship.
- Identifying key considerations for co-sponsorship program design and development, including program requirements and guidelines.
- Establishing effective recruitment strategies.
- Developing key considerations for onboarding co-sponsors.

- Identifying key training topics for co-sponsors and how to incorporate national training resources into local programs.
- Developing key factors and processes to match co-sponsors with refugees.
- Establishing effective monitoring, communication, and management practices.
- Developing co-sponsorship stewardship practices that ensure smooth transition out of co-sponsorship and enable longer-term engagement.
- Developing monitoring, evaluation, and learning processes that support program lifecycle.
